Terms & Conditions

1. As an Organisation of Members who are Queensland based and/or focused, we seek to encourage membership to LSQ of like minded well regarded entities, representing all aspects of the life sciences sector, who are willing to maintain and comply with the relevant standards of their industry sector.
 2. In seeking membership, you are indicating to the Board that you are eligible to be considered for membership, and are not aware of any reason that the Board needs to be advised of, that may limit your ability to be considered as a member of LSQ.
 3. You agree to abide by the rules of the Organisation (and as they may be amended), and understand that ongoing membership is subject to the adherence to same.
 4. Membership is subject to payment of an annual fee (+ GST) determined by FTEs involved in life sciences related activities as outlined as part of this form. The Board may determine that the annual subscription shall be payable in installments.
 5. On application, the applicant determines the level of membership they are seeking. In the event that an applicant decides to pay a lower fee level (irrespective of their FTE's) – Then the membership fee paid will determine the number of votes that Member is entitled to.
 6. In the event that the Board determines that the joining fee is waived – then the membership category is automatically “Associate Member”. At the Board's discretion Members who have had their joining membership fees waived, may be requested to attend events at the “non Member price”.
 7. The Board (at its sole discretion) may waive all or any part of the joining fee payable by a new member.
 8. A right, privilege, or obligation which an entity has by virtue of its membership of the Organisation:
 - a. Is not capable of being transferred or transmitted to another organisation; and
 - b. Terminates upon the cessation of its membership, whether by resignation or otherwise.

 21. Members will adhere to the Queensland Biotechnology Code of Ethics (Update 2006).

LSQ Activities

22. LSQ will undertake activities to assist the members, and these activities may also be made available to non-members at a premium.
23. In order to record and report progress of LSQ, from time to time it will be necessary for members to provide certain metrics which will enable de-identified amalgamated statistics to be reproduced (eg. for annual reports).
24. All data collected will be treated as private and confidential, and where possible, will be gathered in an anonymous format.
25. Member lists, contact details and capability statements will be available to all members and accessible on the LSQ website, on marketing materials, etc.
26. Promotion and marketing by LSQ will be based on member provided material and information.
27. Members (regardless of category or subclass) must nominate one person to act on behalf of their organisation and advise LSQ of any change to this.
28. In accordance with usage guidelines, members are encouraged to utilise the LSQ logo on their marketing material and websites, however, cannot use the LSQ logo without the prior written approval of LSQ.
29. Reasonable criticism of the conduct or views of a member or applicant for membership at any meetings of the Organisation or of its Office Bearers, committees or subcommittees shall be privileged.
30. All communications, correspondence, reports and other papers and documents relating to the admission, reinstatement or disciplining of members (including reports of the Membership Applications and Review Committee) shall be privileged and must not be passed out of the custody of the responsible officer(s), nor shall any of the contents be disclosed other than to members of the Organisation or their duly appointed representatives.

11. In the event that a member decides to cease their membership - they must advise the Board in writing and such notice will be effective as of the date of the next Board Meeting - following receipt of notice.
 12. The Board may terminate membership if a member conducts itself in a way considered to be injurious or prejudicial to the character or interests of the Organisation. This includes filing for bankruptcy or becoming bankrupt.
